

Job Description: Youth Minister

Summary

The Youth Minister oversees a multi-faceted program that supports the spiritual growth of youth in grades six through twelve. The minister will partner with staff, the congregation, and parents to provide opportunities for youth to build Christ-centered relationships, participate fully in worship, and connect faith with daily life.

Area of Emphasis: Youth Ministry

- Invest in the lives of youth, their parents, schools, and community faith partners
- Manage the development of curricula for youth ministry
- Serve as lead teacher for youth ministry, including the identification and equipping of additional adult leaders/teachers
- Manage the congregation's confirmation program for middle school youth.
- Provide oversight to the Youth Discipleship Team, a team of youth and adults that manage
- Provide regular contact and support for St. John's college students
- Serve as a partner in the pastoral care team in the care of youth and their families
- Create a well-rounded youth ministry program with multiple entry points, including but not limited to Sunday night programming, retreats, an annual mission trip, and participation in regional and national youth events
- Work in close tandem with the NextGen staff, which includes ministry to children, youth, and college students
- Work in tandem with the contemporary worship leader in leading worship for and with youth
- Provide consistent and reliable communication with students, program leaders, parents, and the congregation

- Understand and adhere to the congregation's Personnel Guidelines, including the protocol for staff grievances, the Child Protection Policy, Social Media Policy, and the policy surrounding harassment.
- Commit to upholding staff trust and integrity.
- Understand triangulation, proper conflict management, and the importance of healthy space for challenging conversation.
- Serve as a champion and advocate for the congregation's mission and ministry.
