## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The deadline for submitting the application form and other required documents is **5 pm on March 1, 2024.** Please review the following criteria to determine the scholarships for which you are eligible to apply.

- 1. To be eligible for the **Dorothy Click Fesperman Scholarship** one must be:
  - a. A member of St John's Lutheran Church.
  - b. Currently enrolled or accepted in an accredited college or university.
  - c. In financial need.
- 2. To be eligible for the Emily May Brown Memorial Scholarship one must be:
  - a. A resident of Rowan County.
  - b. Enrolled or accepted in a 2 or 4-year college or university.
  - c. In financial need.
  - d. Involved in school and/or community activities.
- 3. To be eligible for the **Thomas E. Gilbert and Viola H. Bailey Scholarship** one must be:
  - a. A member of St John's Lutheran Church or a resident of Rowan County.
  - b. Currently enrolled or accepted in an accredited college or university.
  - c. In financial need.
  - d. Carrying a grade point average of 3.0 or better.
  - e. Studying one of the following major fields of study:
    - (1) Nursing or Medical Professions
    - (2) Veterinary Medicine
    - (3) Lutheran Ministry, Sacred Music or Mission Field
- 4. To be eligible for the **Hugh B. Lyerly Scholarship** one must be:
  - a. A member of St John's Lutheran Church (Salisbury), Union Lutheran Church (Salisbury), or St Mark's Lutheran Church (Mooresville).
  - b. Currently enrolled or accepted in an accredited college or university.
  - c. Academic and possess leadership abilities as well as financial need.
  - d. Concerned for his community/church by having been active in service activities/events within the community/congregation.
  - e. Receiving a grade point average of 3.0 or better.
  - f. Studying one of the following major fields of study:
    - (1) Education (leading to a teaching career in any subject).
    - (2) Christian Education (leading to service in the Lutheran Church or the Lutheran Ministry).

- 5. To be eligible for the **Scott Rierson Scholarship** one must:
  - a. Be a Member of St John's Lutheran Church, Salisbury, NC
  - b. Be enrolled/accepted institution of higher education
  - c. Have a grade point average of 3.0 or greater
  - d. Be involved in extracurricular activities or school leadership
- 6. To be eligible for the **Bruce Alden Ketner**, **Jr Scholarship** one must:
  - a. Have a commendable school record.
  - b. Be involved in school and community activities.
  - c. Be enrolled or accepted in a college or university.
- 7. To be eligible for the Carl Edgar and Edna Cauble Leazer Church Music Scholarship one must be:
  - a. An active member of St John's or any other Lutheran congregation.
  - b. Currently enrolled in high school or enrolled or accepted in an accredited college or university or school of music and carry a grade point average of 3.0 or better.
  - c. Enrolled in continuing education programs or seminars devoted to church music or actively engaged in the study and practice of church music.
- 8. To be eligible for the Margaret Cline and Ernest Crawford Safrit, Sr. Scholarship one must be:
  - a. A member of St John's Lutheran Church (Salisbury) or St Paul's Lutheran Church (Salisbury).
  - b. Current enrollment or acceptance in an accredited 4-year college or university.
  - c. A minimum GPA of 3.0 (out of 4.0) or higher (if currently enrolled in a college/university), or a minimum high school GPA of 3.5 (out of 4.0) or higher if accepted by an appropriate college/university, but not yet enrolled.
  - d. Evidence of financial need.
  - e. Acceptance in a school, college, or Department of Education as an Education major, or as preeducation major, with a course of study leading to a teaching degree in any subject area.
  - f. Previous involvement in school and community activities.
