ENDOWMENT GRANT GUIDELINES

The Benevolent Foundation of St. John's Lutheran Church 200 West Innes Street Salisbury, North Carolina

- I. Successful grant applications respond to ministry-related needs in Salisbury and Rowan County, the North Carolina Synod ELCA, and the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, including its global ministry affiliates. Typical Project areas include:
 - o Ministry supported by institutions and agencies to which this congregation relates
 - Support to new congregations
 - Leadership development
 - o Global Missions
 - o Education
 - o Ministry in the realm of mercy and justice, including poverty, racial justice, and homelessness
 - Global missions
- II. Grant applications are considered twice annually under the following schedule:

- III. No proceeds shall be expended beyond a period of one year. Any request for programs or projects that would extend beyond one year must be resubmitted for further consideration.
- IV. Organizations will be eligible for a Grant once per calendar year.
- Reporting. Successful applicants will provide a project report by the date indicated in the Grant schedule (above).
 In addition to a final expense summary, the report should include a project summary and digital picture, both of which will be included in the Foundation's annual report. Of note:
 - 1. A project report is required before further Endowment Grants will be considered from the sponsoring organization/agency.
 - 2. Any unused funds should be returned to St. John's Lutheran Church. Unused funds will be made available for future projects.
